Sometimes we cover 100%, sometimes we just lend a helping paw---whatever it takes to get the situation managed for our four legged friends.

Rex is a little Boston Terrier who badly needed his teeth cleaned. Rex shares his life and love with a senior citizen on a fixed income, who couldn't afford the procedure. Rex's Dad paid \$400, while **Angel Paw** covered the rest of the dental work—just over \$600 in additional expenses. After losing 34 teeth, Rex (and his 3 remaining teeth) is a happy guy!
