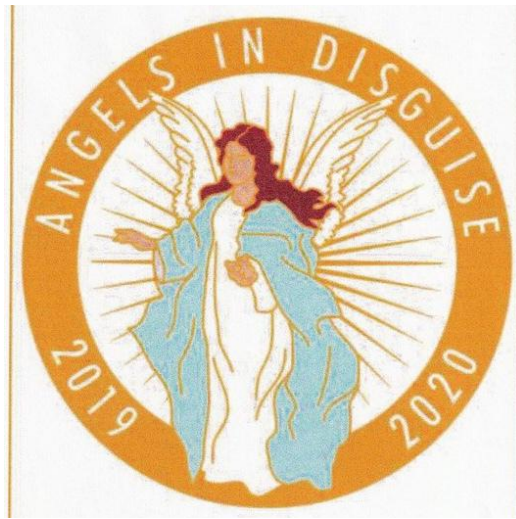

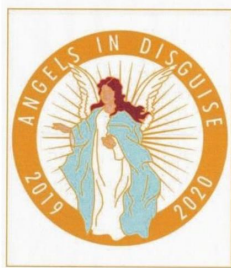

ST JUDE DREAM HOMES UPDATE

This is a very unique year for the St. Jude Dream Home Campaigns across the county. There are no Sellathons or Open Houses; despite that, Dream Homes are selling out.

Kudos to our **Colorado Springs** Dream Home Team, they sold out early, all 9,250 tickets! Hard to believe this was their 7th Dream Home by Covington Homes. Colorado Springs received 3rd place recognition during the IC Awards announcement for last year's Dream Home, donating \$900,040 to St. Jude.

The Denver Dream Home campaign kicked off July 9; ticket sales hit an all-time record—over 6,300 the first day! We're just three weeks into the campaign with less than 4,000 tickets to sell out for a total of 15,000 tickets. KDVR Fox 31 did a great spot light the first day at the home interviewing vendors and Oakwood Homes. This is the 10th Dream Home for Denver.

The drawing is September 3. Denver received 1st place recognition during the IC Awards announcement for last year's Dream Home, donating \$1,176,262 to St. Jude.

What an awesome feeling to be able to support the kids at St. Jude. Now, more than ever, they need our support. Many of their other fund raising events have been cancelled or are being held virtually.
