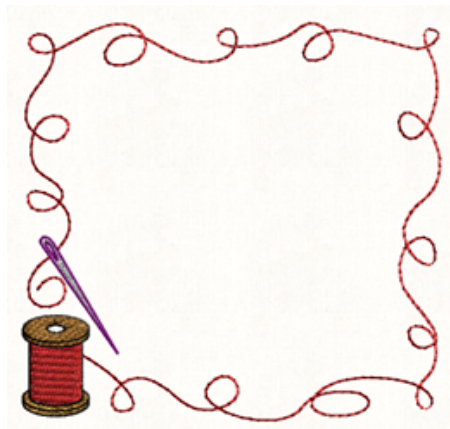

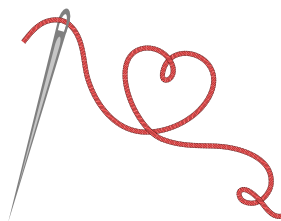
2021- 2022 State ESA President

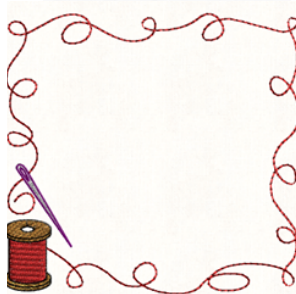

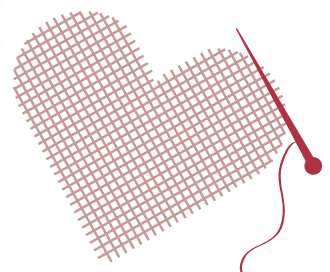

Hope for Heroes

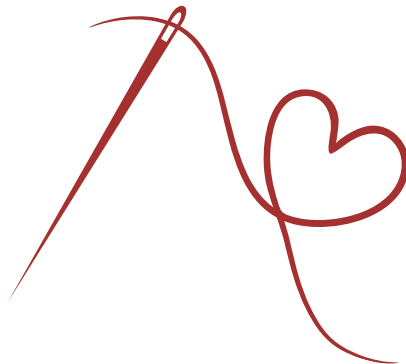
Hello, I am Susie Morris, Chapter Sigma Rho #5014, Hope for Heroes Chair for this past year 2020/2021.

Congratulations to everyone for a great state convention and all those award winners!

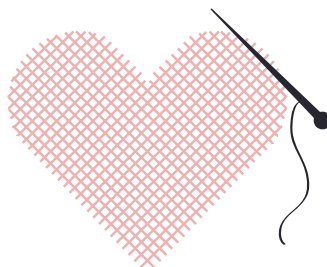

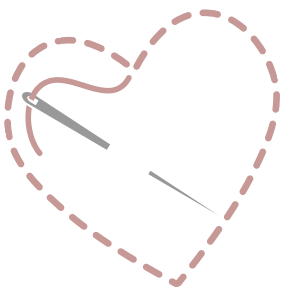

Nut sales are an ongoing fund raiser for our philanthropic account. We also collected coins from our individual piggy banks to add to philanthropic causes.

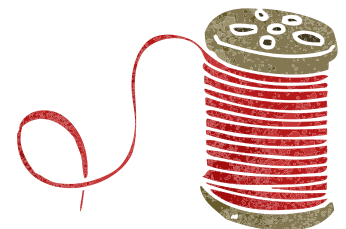

Chapter News Gamma Chi #3668 Loveland

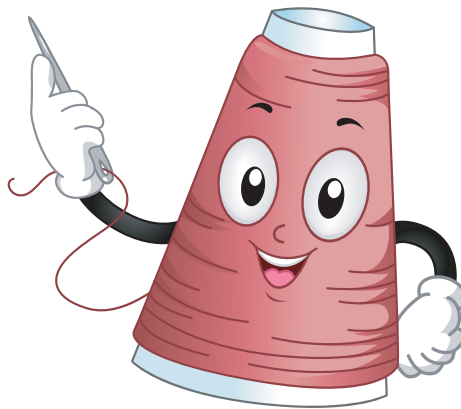
Our chapter was so pleased to see so many again at Convention. Congratulations to all the work everyone did this past year. We are looking forward to in person meetings on the chapter and state level.

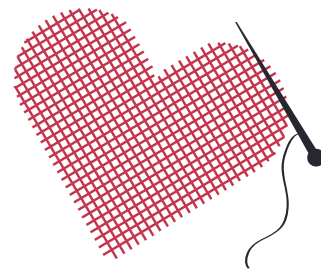
The regular business meeting was conducted by President Jessica Filla. Secret sister gifts were enjoyed by those receiving them.

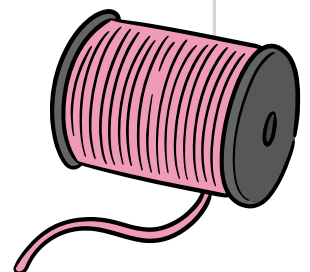
To incoming President, Pam, I know we are in very good hands leading us into the future! Congratulations!

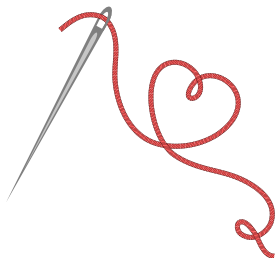

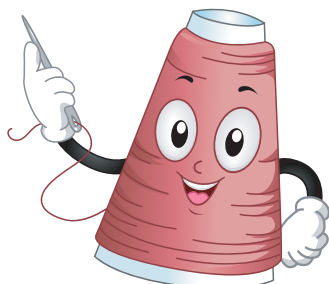

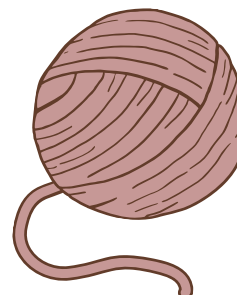
